## Curriculum Policy

### 【Doctoral Program】

1. To promote academic construction in the fields of health support and care system nursing, and develop excellent educators and researchers, who can play active roles in various fields, such as international society, by encouraging students to acquire highly specialized knowledge and skills, and practice advanced research in response to the advancements in medical care and research, that meet the needs of the local health care and welfare fields.
2. To improve academic knowledge and skills in specialized fields by arranging advanced seminars, advanced seminar practices and research for thesis in each specialized field.
3. To augment multifaceted specialized knowledge and skills, and cultivate advanced academic abilities and research practice in the field of nursing, by arranging supporting subjects.
4. To promote special research by encouraging students to acquire advanced academic construction and research skills in nursing, through research planning and implementation, preliminary doctoral dissertation reviews, publications in relevant academic journals, doctoral dissertation reviews, and final examinations.

## Diploma Policy

### 【Doctoral Program】

**In the Doctoral Program of the Graduate School of Nursing Sciences, students will be approved on completion, and the degree of Doctor of Nursing Science will be awarded to those, who are recognized as having the following abilities:**

1. Students must possess a broad perspective and rich academic knowledge necessary to carry out research and education in response to the increasing sophistication of medical care, associated with scientific development and technological progress, and the diversification of health issues associated with structural changes in society and internationalization.
2. Students must have the will and ability to fully utilize their broad perspectives and rich academic knowledge, and independently sustain original and advanced research activities.
3. The doctoral dissertation must be appropriate for the doctoral degree in terms of research purposes (problem statement), research methods, implementation, analysis, appropriateness of discussions, originality of research, potential for academic development and significance, and ethical considerations, and a portion of the dissertation has been published in an academic journal as a reference paper.
